- Athlete, coaching and official's development based on the LTAD model.
- High performance sport to include competition (Commonwealth Championships and Lifesaving World Championships) and support of the National team, coaches and managers.
- National championships in lifeguard emergency response, lifesaving sport pool and lifesaving sport surf.
- Research, develop and implement technical rules related to Lifesaving Sport in Canada.
- Develop of a Federal Government lobbying strategy aimed at Sport Canada to gain recognition for Lifesaving Sport.
- Work on alternate funding strategies for Lifesaving Sport development throughout Canada.
